The Australasian College of Paramedicine recognises the vital role which research plays in the development of the discipline of paramedicine and in advancing patient care outcomes. This award recognises a student who demonstrates excellence in research while undertaking the paramedic degree at Flinders University.

The prize shall be awarded to the student enrolled in the Bachelor of Paramedic Science who gains the highest overall grade in the topic HLTH3105: Quantitative Methods for Social Health Research.

The value or form of the prize or scholarship (the total funds provided for initial establishment and the amount to be awarded to awardees);

The value of the prize shall be \$500 (Generously donated by the Australasian College of Paramedicine).

The frequency of its award and the maximum number of awardees who may receive the prize or scholarship in any given year;

The prize will be awarded annually. In the event of two or more eligible students receiving the same final grade for the topic, the prize will be awarded to the student who has the highest grade point average (GPA) attained in topics undertaken towards the paramedic degree.

The academic criteria or other criteria for the award of the prize or scholarship; The prize will be awarded to the student who achieves the highest overall final grade in the topic HLTH3105: Quantitative Methods for Social Health Research in the Bachelor of Paramedic Science at Flinders University.
