FOR STUDENTS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE

The Broadcasting Services Act 1992 requires that "online accounts are not provided to children without the permission of a parent or responsible adult". To ensure compliance with this Act the University is not able to provide Internet access to those student who are not yet 18 years of age. Access may be provisioned after the consent of a parent or a responsible adult. Below is the consent form that must be lodged in order to obtain Internet access.

Instructions for submitting this form:

1. Complete **ALL** details required on the consent form
2. Have the form signed and dated by your parent or guardian
3. Lodge the completed and signed form with your Faculty Computer support desk or the Central Library FLO Student Help Desk, showing your student identification to obtain Internet access.
