Pre-Placement Compliance Checklist (Non-SA student)

Students undertaking a placement for diabetes must complete the below compliance and upload it to InPlace for verification before placement commences.

- Please allow adequate time to complete all pre-placement requirements:
 - o Criminal History screenings (DHS clearances, Police Checks) may take 6-8 weeks.
 - Vaccinations may interfere with tuberculosis test results; therefore, it is strongly recommended to complete the Tuberculosis Service screening questionnaire <u>before</u> commencing any vaccinations.
- All documents must be valid for the entire duration of your placement.
- Keep all documents safe and secure
- Upload all required documents via InPlace. Consult the InPlace User Guide for help.
- Complete any additional venue specific compliance requirements, as requested.

Working with Children Check	Students must have a valid Working with Children's check for the state where they are undertaking placement.		5 years	
, Cinco Gireon	All students require a National Coordinated Criminal History Check (NCCHC) that specifies Unsupervised Contact with Vulnerable Groups and states the purpose as being for University Placement within the Aged/Health care sector. For international students, an international criminal history check (ICHC) is valid for only three months after arrival into Australia. International students must supply an NCCHC within 3 months of arrival, and prior to placement commencement date, unless otherwise instructed. A certified translation is also required if the international criminal history check is not in English. Fit2Work is an acceptable provider to obtain your individual ICHC. When you have a NCCHC and ICHC Police Check combine both documents in one file and upload into InPlace.		3 years (NCCHC) Or 3 months (ICHC)	
Infectious diseases and immunisations				
Tuberculosis screening	Complete the online SA Tuberculosis Service screening questionnaire or the TB screening available in the state where the student is undertaking placement. It is strongly recommended students do this before commencing any vaccinations. Depending on the assessment outcome, clearance may be given straight away, or additional testing and/or a chest clinic appointment may be required.		indefinite*

Pre-Placement Compliance Checklist (Non-SA student)

Immunisation Compliance Certificate	Provide immunity evidence of the Vaccine Preventable Diseases (VPDs) listed on the Flinders University Immunisation Compliance Certificate. The form must be completed by a medical practitioner. Ensure the medical practitioner provides copies of the supporting evidence identified on the Form B including vaccination dates and blood test results (serology). If vaccination against poliomyelitis has been completed but not documented, students can complete a Statutory Declaration and provide this to the medical practitioner.	indefinite
Influenza Vaccination Certificate	Book an annual influenza vaccination from an immunisations provider. This form can be used Influenza vaccination certificate (PDF)	Annually
