SOCIAL WORK FIELD PLACEMENT – ATTENDANCE VARIATION EXPLANATION

In exceptional circumstances, the Australian Social Work Education and Accreditation Standards (ASWEAS) allows for students to undertake a placement a minimum of 2 days (15 hours) per week. Placements that are 2 days per week <u>must</u> include at least two full-time (5-day) block periods, unless approval is given in line with exceptional circumstances as defined by the ASWEAS.

Examples of exceptional circumstances include:

- Serious health issue, illness or disability which impacts on the student's capacity to attend placement more than two full weekdays per week. Students will be asked to discuss their University Access Plans with the Topic Coordinator or provide medical certificate in these cases.
- Significant carer responsibilities (e.g. a disabled child).

The following are some examples of circumstances which would **NOT** be considered extenuating:

- Other work commitments
- Holidays / Moving house
- Changing jobs
- Not being aware of placement attendance requirements (this information is made available to students prior to accepting offers into the degree)

IMPORTANT: Any request for a variation to placement days will impact on the placements available to approved applicants as the majority of agencies require a minimum placement attendance of four full days per week. As a result, while the Placement Matching Team will make every effort to accommodate an approved placement variation, the availability of a suitable agency <u>cannot be guaranteed</u>.
