Program of study

After successful completion of the one year Education (Primary R-7) Pathway, students will transfer to one of the following courses:

- the [Bachelor of Education \(Primary R-7\)](#), [Bachelor of Arts](#) double degree. Students will be guaranteed entry on the condition that a GPA of 5.00 (Credit) or higher is achieved over the 36 units of study and a grade of Pass or higher has been achieved in the EDUC topics listed below. Upon transferring students will receive 36 units of credit transfer towards the double degree.
- the [Bachelor of Arts](#) (BA). Upon transferring students will receive 36 units of credit transfer.

Students who do not meet the criteria for guaranteed entry into the Bachelor of Education (Primary R-7), Bachelor of Arts may apply to transfer into this degree via the normal competitive admission process.

Except with the permission of the Dean (Education), no EDUC topic may be taken more than twice
