BA students must complete one core topic (COMS1001*), one major (8 topics), one minor, different from the major (5 topics), and elective topics to reach a total of 108 units.

However, BAMTSP students must note: in order to qualify for the Master of Teaching (Secondary) students must do a minimum of 6 topics in this second area of study. Therefore, students in the BAMTSP take a Teaching Major (6 topics) instead of a minor, but it will be listed as a BA minor on your academic record.
