

BACHELOR OF PSYCHOLOGY (HONOURS): MID-YEAR ENTRY

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This suggested study plan must be read in conjunction with the Course Rule for the Bachelor of Psychology (Honours) found online here: <https://students.flinders.edu.au/my-course/course-rules/undergrad/bpsy>.

This degree requires the completion of 144 units with a grade of P or NGP or better in each topic (28x 4.5 unit topics and 2x 9 unit topics). Topics in this template are worth 4.5 units unless stated otherwise.

Psychology pre-requisites are noted in **red**. Students must have passed the listed pre-requisite topics/units to proceed with their enrolment. Owing to the strict pre-requisites for Psychology topics, **mid year entry students are not permitted to commence their core Psychology topics in their first semester.**

In order to progress to the third year of the Bachelor of Psychology (Honours) program a student must normally have achieved a GPA of 5 (an average grade of CR) in all Second Year Psychology topics attempted. Failure to achieve the required GPA may constitute prima facie evidence of unsatisfactory progress for the purposes of the University's Policy on Student Progress.

Students cannot proceed to any topics in the honours year unless they have completed 108 units (24 topics) constituting the requirements for the first three years of the Bachelor of Psychology (Honours).

In order to progress to the final year of the Bachelor of Psychology (Honours) program a student must normally have achieved a GPA of 5.25 in all Third Year Psychology topics attempted. Students who fail to achieve the required GPA or choose not to continue to the fourth year of the program may apply to graduate with the [Bachelor of Psychological Science](#).

Also note that the Honours year can only be started in semester one, there is no mid-year commencement. The honours year can be undertaken full-time or part-time (coursework [PSYC7056A, PSYC7056B, PSYC7006, PSYC7007] in the first year, with the thesis [PSYC7002A, PSYC7002B] in the second year).
