\* Students can apply to replace these 3 topics with the 13.5 unit Public Policy Internship (POAD9140). Internship places are limited. Where demand is greater than supply, internship places will be allocated based on student GPA.

Students wishing to undertake the public policy internship should contact the topic coordinator, Associate Professor Cassandra Star, preferably 8 weeks before the semester start date. This allows time to choose an internship project, to apply to the agency, to undertake an interview with the internship agency, and to allow time for security checking processes by the agency, as required.
