The Global Experience team at Flinders University oversees all international inbound and outbound enrolled student activities including the bilateral semester student exchange and study abroad agreements, involving over seventy exchange partners worldwide. The Global Experience Vision is to ensure that every student at Flinders University has the opportunity to engage in transformative international experiences by offering access to a variety of high-quality, well-supported programs.

Our strategy is focused on leveraging where possible our prioritised international partnerships that provide access to high quality academic, industry and cultural experiences for our students. The Global Experience team oversees all international College-led short-term experiences, International Work Integrated Learning (WIL) placements, New Colombo Plan Programs, Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade mobility funding and study tours.

What does the Global Experience team do?	The Global Experience (GE) team welcomes inbound exchange students from more than seventy universities worldwide and offers outbound exchange programs for current students to study at one of our partner institutions across the globe. The GE team also supports the strategic growth of short-term mobility experiences, placements and international WIL.

P: 82012727 E: global.experience@flinders.edu.au  The GE team at Flinders University actively promotes overseas study opportunities through information sessions held during Semester 1 (O'Week) and throughout the academic year. Educate and provide support to students to navigate the exchange application process. The GE team collaborates with college peers to conduct workshops that provide specialised advice, helping students successfully submit their exchange applications.  Following attendance at a study overseas information session, students can book one-on-one consultations to receive personalised support. These consultations help students identify, select, and apply for programs while also assisting them in navigating the credit approval and application processes.
